Using Oracle JDeveloper

This course will also teach you how to add portlets, documents, discussion forums, links and search using Oracle JDeveloper (with the embedded WebCenter Portal Framework extension). You'll also learn how to enable users to compose and edit WebCenter application pages at run-time.

Oracle WebCenter Portal Framework

Oracle WebCenter Portal Framework is an Oracle JDeveloper design-time extension that breaks down boundaries between Web-based portals and enterprise applications. It also provides the runtime portal and Web 2.0 framework.
